

How to become more effective in managing behaviours in the classroom, playgrounds and friendship groups.



This program encourages principles of excellence in Early Childhood by managing challenging behaviours. Training Content

- Techniques how to empower teachers to set firm boundaries and behaviour etiquette in the classroom and playground.
- How to use the LMP Teaching Tool.
- How children adopt behaviours over time.
